LION Cub Commitment Form

Pack _____ commits to conduct the Lion Program as outlined by the National Council.

The Pack is responsible for appointing a Lion Guide for each den who will have the following responsibilities:

- Has previous experience as a Den Leader
- Works directly with the other Den and Pack Leaders to ensure that the den is active and a part of the pack
- Plans the initial Den Meetings and Outings
- Coordinates "shared" leadership among the Lion Cub adult partners
- Ensures that each Lion and his Adult Partner have the opportunity to be a host team which plans and executes the den activities and rotates the responsibility
- Mentors the Adult partners in how to deliver the Lion Program
- Attends pack leader meetings
- Ensures transition from Lion Cub to Tiger
- Prepares Lions for Day Camp at the end of the year if appropriate
- Provide feedback as requested in regard to the program

The Lion Den is expected to conduct the program as outlined in the materials. This will assist the National Council to gather appropriate feedback and gather data as the program is executed on a broad scale.

As outlined in the program, the Den should be invited to participate in 2 or 3 pack meetings during the year. In addition, the Den should not be expected to participate in fund raising, overnight camping, or activities such as shooting sports.
