### What is National Youth Leadership Training?

NYLT is an exciting, action-packed program designed to provide Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts, Venturers, Sea Scouts, and Explorers with leadership skills and experiences they can use in their home units, personal lives, schools and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others. This is a 6 day course, youth will meet and work with other scouts to form patrols and form one troop. The course is led by a volunteer staff of youth and adults experienced in training future youth leaders.



#### Who may attend NYLT?

- Scouts who are at least 13 years old , first class, preferably have at least one week-long camping experience.
- Venturer, Sea Scouts 14-20 years old.
- Before attending NYLT take Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops/Crews ILST/C.



#### What is the purpose of NYLT?

NYLT is to expand on ILST/C focusing on

- \* providing each youth with a toolbox of leadership skills
- \* learning the methods of leading and teaching EDGE (Explain, Demonstrate, Guide and Enable)
- \* learning what a leader must **BE**, what a leader must **KNOW**, what a leader must **DO**
- \* finding personal visions and setting S.M.A.R.T. goals
- \* operates according to the Scout Oath and Law
- \* meeting other scouts and have fun!

#### What is the cost? \$250

If you pay in full 30 days prior to the course you only pay \$250, a \$50 deposit will hold your place. For Winter course full payment and application is due by Dec 19<sup>th</sup>, 2018. For Summer course full payment and application is due by June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019. If paid less than 30 days fee is \$275.

Because of the benefits of this training to the unit, it is highly recommended that the unit consider paying part of participants fee's. Make payment to Greater Alabama Council, BSA. Submit payment and application by mail or at either scout office.
