Cub Scout Leader Specific Training

8:00 AM – 9:30 AM *Introduction to Cub Scouting*

If you have attended the Introduction to Cub Scouting (have attended basic Cub Scout Leader training before) you only need to attend the split session for your current role.

9:30 – 11:30 *Leader Specific Split Sessions.*

BSA Troop Committee Challenge Training

8:00 AM – 11:00 AM

Troop Committee Training is for troop committee members (parents and other troop leaders are invited). Teaches responsibilities of a troop committee, how the committee should be organized, and their positions to be filled.

BSA Scoutmaster / Assistant Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training

8:00 AM - 2:30 PM

This is the initial training for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters (and other interested persons). This course covers the essentials of their leadership positions and provides information to help them become successful Scout leaders. Learn about working with the boys, troop organization, the patrol method, the outdoor program, the advancement program, and program planning. To be fully trained, Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters must also attend the Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills Training (OLS).

Den Chief Training

08:00 AM – 11:30 AM

The Den Chief who completes this training session will be better able to function in the position, although the new den chief will certainly welcome the understanding leader's guidance. Cub Scout leaders will understand a Den Chief's role.

Venture Leader Specific Training

8:00 AM – 1:00 PM

This training introduces adult Venturing crew leaders to the basic information needed to operate a crew. It is for: chartered organization personnel, Advisors/associate Advisors, committee members, commissioners, and other adults.

Merit Badge Counselor Training

11:00 AM – 12:00 PM

Learn all about being a merit badge counselor, from getting registered to how the merit badge process works. No charge if you only take this course. This course is a one-time requirement for all Merit Badge Counselors.

This is Scouting introduces the mission, vision, and values of the Scouting program and gives a general overview of the program.
