Participant Requirements:

Must be a registered **adult or youth** member of the Boy Scouts of America.

Youth must be 14 (or 13 **and** finished the 8th grade).

Youth must have completed their unit's version of Leadership Training (i.e. ILST, ILSC).

Adults must be trained in their leadership position.

Must have an Annual BSA Health and Medical Record (Parts, A, B, and C) and meet the physical demands of a backcountry course.
