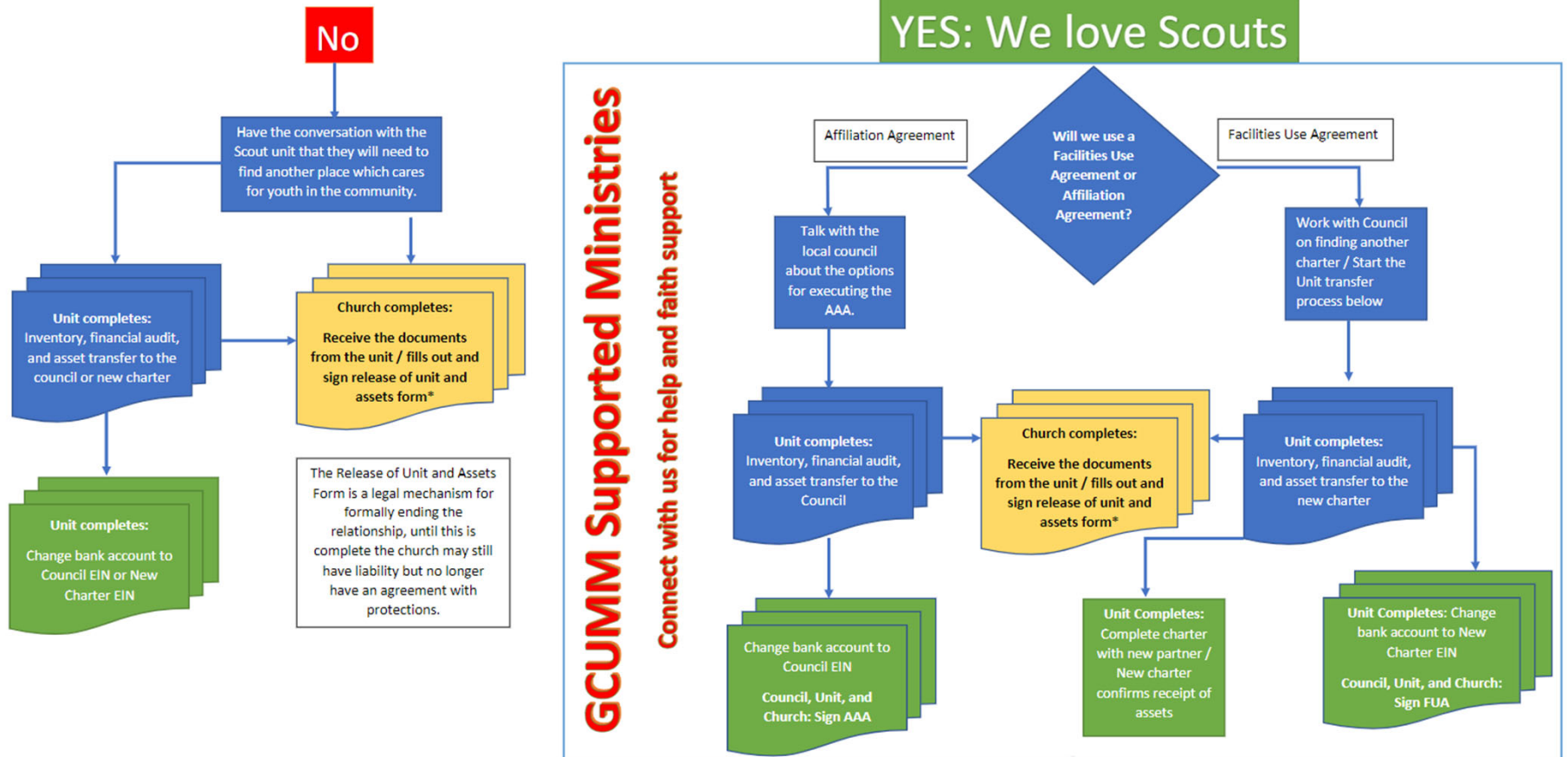

Greater Alabama Council (GAC) Owned Units

- **Institution Head will be a GAC Staff Member or Council level Volunteer.**
- **Chartered Representative will be a Council or District Volunteer.**
- **Unit Assets including trailers & buses will not need to be transferred to the GAC.**
- **Trailer Tags and Insurance will be provided by the Unit.**



Greater Alabama Council (GAC) Owned Units

- Units will need their own EIN number for financial accounts.
- Units will submit a yearly annual program plan with proposed budget, along with a final accounting from the previous year. (between July & August)
- Unless there is an issue, unit will NOT use the Council's Tax-Exempt number.
