**James T. Stephens
Eagle Scout Scholarship Award
Criteria and Required Process**

The Greater Alabama Council announces that two (2) to four (4) Eagle Scout Scholarship Awards have been established by James T. Stephens. These awards are open to Eagle Scouts of the Greater Alabama Council, Boy Scouts of America. The scholarships are \$4,000 yearly for up to four years of college. To be eligible, applicants must meet the following criteria and adhere to the required process:

THE SCHOLARSHIP IS FOR MATRICULATION TO COLLEGE IN THE FALL FOLLOWING HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION. THE SCHOLARSHIP IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR DELAYED ENTRY TO COLLEGE.

- ◆ Be an Eagle Scout of the Greater Alabama Council, Boy Scouts of America by February 2, 2026.
- ◆ Submit an original application and required documents to the Council Service Center in Liberty Park no later than February 2, 2026 (electronically submitted copies will not be accepted).
- ◆ Be a senior in high school.
- ◆ Have taken the ACT or SAT exam.

The scholarships will be awarded to applicants demonstrating both merit and need. The \$4,000 yearly is available for tuition and books. To maintain the scholarship for four years, scholastic performance must be appropriate.

REQUIRED

- ◆ Completed application form with essay.
- ◆ Official ACT or SAT score affixed upon the official high school transcript including courses in progress, grade 12. Official transcripts must be in a sealed envelope with a signature or school stamp across the seal. (Copies of transcripts or test scores will not be accepted.)
- ◆ Economic Capacity Information Sheet.

All documentation must be received in the Council Service Center on or before the end of the day, February 2, 2026.
